The dry diving suit must be used and maintained as described in the operating instructions to safeguard the protection against fuel oils while diving in contaminated waters.

Before diving in contaminated waters, the diving suit shall be completed by diving equipment suitable for usage in contaminated waters. Protection against contamination has to be ensured by using of neck sealed diving helmets and suitable diving gloves in sealed connection to the diving suit. Further, usage of double diaphragm exhaust valves should be considered.

The expiry date is determined by the validity of the leading EC Type-Examination Certificate referred above.
