

DRYSUIT TESTING

1. Flip the drysuit inside out, zip up the suit ensuring the closure is fastened tightly.
2. Using a bungee cord, tie off one wrist seal and the neck seal.
3. Prepare a bucket with soapy water.
4. Place your air source in the open wrist seal, sealing the closure with your hands.
5. Fill the suit with air.
6. Begin dabbing the suit in the suspected areas in order to identify any leaks.
7. Mark the effected area with a pen and let the suit dry before repairing.
